ONDM 2009

ONDM is a major European-based international conference focusing on the area of ultra high-speed transmission, switching and optical networking in general. The conference has gained a great reputation within the research and industrial community world-wide. Many consider the event instrumental to the steady EU-funded research and Industrial activities within the technical areas supported. The conference has been founded in 1997, under the visionary

motto "Optical Internet" and is technically sponsored by IFIP and IEEE. The 13th International Conference on Optical Networking Design and Modeling - ONDM 2009 - will be held in Braunschweig (Brunswick), Germany, on Feb 18-20, 2009.

As it is established practice at ONDM, the 13th instalment will focus on cutting-edge, state-of-the-art research in optical networking and newly emerging areas. ONDM will also encourage submissions of research papers that relate to the topics of optical networking and to other areas and disciplines, such as integration of optical and wireless networks or the role of optical network for the future Internet design. Controversial ideas and approaches and their open discussion are strongly encouraged. Moreover, ONDM in Braunschweig will contribute to the community strengthening by inciting interactivity among the senior and junior participants as well as among the industrial and academic participants, in Europe and internationally.

HSPR 2009

HSPR 2009 brings together researchers working on the forefront topics of switching and routing and the associated topics of architecture, performance evaluation, algorithms, traffic control, protection, multi-layer and multi-domain networking and security. We are witnessing important design aspects such as power usage, design efficiency, secure routing, and path optimization. Presentations of the latest research results provide a unique opportunity at this workshop for discussions and exchange of ideas to further the knowledge base in this field.

Call for Papers

The aim of the 2009 International conference on High Performance Switching and Routing (HPSR 2009) is to identify new trends in research and technologies in the area of high-speed, high-capacity and high-quality switching and routing for both wired and wireless networks. HPSR 2009 will comprise technical sessions for presentation of novel research results, panel sessions for

discussion of hot topics, and tutorials presented by leading international experts.
