## Upcoming Events Future Network & Mobile Summit 2010

Future Network and MobileSummit 2010 takes place in the Historical City of Florence, 16 - 18 June 2010. This is the nineteenth in a series of Annual Conferences supported by the European Commission, which regularly attracts over 600 delegates from industry and research to share experiences and research results, identify future trends, discuss business opportunities and identify opportunities for international research collaboration under the ICT Theme of Framework Programme 7 (FP7). It will thus contribute to showcasing European research in the field, and position it within the multiplicity of

related initiatives supported in other regions of the world.

In the context of convergence, the 19th Future Network and MobileSummit will address the challenges of building the Future Internet, based on mobile, wireless and fixed broadband communications infrastructures.

Supported by the European Commission and eMobility, the reputation of the Future Network and MobileSummit (previously known as ICT-MobileSummit) is based on high quality networking, plenary sessions that discuss strategic issues in core thematic areas and paper sessions that showcase original results in all areas of mobile, wireless and fixed broadband communications systems and networks.

## Promoting Western Balkan research excellence in the fields of eHealth and Network & Service Infrastructures

The EU-funded project ICT-WEB-PROMS is organising two thematic workshops on 10 May 2010 in Skopje, Macedonia, for the themes "ICT for Health in the Western Balkan countries and the EU" (morning session) and "Network and Service Infrastructures – the future Internet" (afternoon session). On the day after, 11 May, a follow up workshop will explain all procedural, administrative and financial aspects of participation in FP7/ICT.

The focus of HPSR 2010 is the innovative technology of high-speed, high-capacity and high-quality data transmission and switching for wired and wireless networks.

The 9th Conference of Telecommunication, Media and Internet Techno-Economics (CTTE) will be held in Ghent, Belgium, June 7-9, 2010.
