Future Network and MobileSummit 2010 took place in the Historical City of Florence, 16 - 18 June 2010. This was the nineteenth in a series of Annual Conferences supported by the European Commission, which regularly attracts over 600 delegates from industry and research to share experiences and research results, identify future trends, discuss business opportunities and identify opportunities for international research collaboration under the ICT Theme of Framework Programme 7 (FP7). As every year it was followed the Future Network & MobileSummit Exhibition which showcases research results and applications through technology demonstrations.



BONE participated with a stand at this year's Future Network and MobileSummit Exhibition that highlighted the research work that is being carried out in the NoE. The booth was highly visited and many BONE

partners was there to support the event like IBBT, U of Essex, UniBo, UoP and others.

Additionally during the Summit a BONE panel on Green Internet was also held that attracted a lot of attention.
